DGP C.V.Anand Reviews Police Station Reorganisation Across Four Commissionerates

Hyderabad TSIT: Director General of Police C.V. Anand on Thursday conducted a high-level review meeting on the proposed reorganisation of police station jurisdictions in the Hyderabad Police Commissionerate, Cyberabad Police Commissionerate, Malkajgiri Police Commissionerate and Future City Police Commissionerate. During the meeting, the Commissioners of the four Commissionerates presented detailed proposals on the restructuring of police station lim-



its, jurisdictional realignment and administrative requirements. DGP directed officials to undertake the reorganisation strictly in accordance with the Government Orders (GOs). He instructed that police station boundaries should be aligned with municipal limits, revenue divisions and court jurisdictions to ensure better administrative coordination. Emphasising the need for long-term planning, C.V. Anand said the reorganisation should take into account future urban expansion, population growth and evolving administrative needs. He also instructed officials to consider the views of all stakeholders while finalising the proposals.

Lakpathi Yadagiri Goud Defends Yadagirigutta Trust Board Urges Leaders to Avoid Unnecessary Controversy

Hyderabad TSIT: TPCC Secretary Lakpathi Yadagiri Goud has appealed to political leaders and party members to refrain from creating unnecessary controversy over the constitution of the Yadagirigutta Temple Trust Board, stating that the State Government has ensured representation for all communities in the governing



body.Backing Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy, Lakpathi Yadagiri Goud said every decision taken by the Chief Minister is aimed at the overall development of Telangana and should be viewed in that spirit. He said criticism of the Trust Board's composition was unwarranted and ignored the government's efforts to provide inclusive representation.

Commissioner Srijana reviews monsoon preparedness measures

Hyderabad, July 2: Cyberabad Municipal Corporation Commissioner Srijana reviewed monsoon preparedness during the Joint Action Teams (JATs) Orientation Programme organised by the Telangana Integrated Command and Control Centre (TGICCC).The programme brought together officials from civic, police, disaster response, fire services, water supply, and meteorological departments to strengthen coordination during the rainy season. Commissioner Srijana stressed the need for seamless coordination among departments and directed officials to



improve the use of location-specific weather forecasts from the India Meteorological Department (IMD) for timely emergency response.She also instructed departments to prepare short-term, medium-term, and long-term action plans for monsoon-related works to ensure quick response to emergencies and improve public safety during the season.

Tribal MLAs Submit Charter of Demands to CM Revanth Reddy



Hyderabad TSIT: A delegation of Tribal legislators, led by Tribal Welfare Minister met Chief Minister at the Secretariat on Thursday and submitted a memorandum seeking enhanced development initiatives for tribal and agency areas across the State.MLAs urged Chief Minister to sanction an additional 2,000 Indiramma houses for Assembly constituencies located in agency areas.They also sought early issuance of land titles for podu lands and implementation of the Indira Giri Jala Vikasam scheme to strengthen irrigation and improve the livelihoods of tribal communities.

Veerlapalli Shankar Alleges Financial Mismanagement by BRS



RANGAREDDY : Shadnagar MLA and Chairman of State Public Sector Undertakings Veerlapalli Shankar on Thursday accused the previous BRS government of leaving Telangana burdened with heavy debts, pending dues and financial mismanagement. Addressing a press conference at his camp office, he alleged that dues were left unpaid across several departments, including fee reimbursement, power utilities, RTC, gram panchayats and contractors. He also claimed that several welfare promises and development works, including Double Bedroom Housing projects in Shadnagar, remained incomplete.

Archana Assumes Charge as New RDO of Nagarkurnool

The South India Times // Nagarkurnool : Archana has officially assumed charge as the new Revenue Divisional Officer (RDO) of Nagarkurnool. On the occasion, she paid a courtesy visit to District Collector Hemanta Keshav Patil at the Collectorate and presented him with a bouquet. Prior to her new posting, Archana served as Deputy Collector in the Hyderabad Metropolitan Development Authority. She was appointed as the RDO of Nagarkurnool as part of the recent transfers of government officials. After assuming charge, Archana said she would strive to provide transparent, accountable, and efficient administration to the people. She also assured that priority would be given to resolving public grievances promptly and ensuring better delivery of government services.



All departments must coordinate to ensure timely justice for sexual assault victims: Warangal CP



Warangal, July 2: Warangal Police Commissioner N. Shwetha directed all concerned departments to work in close coordination to ensure timely justice and comprehensive support for victims of sexual assault. Speaking at a review meeting held at the Warangal Police

Commissionerate on Thursday, she said Bharosa Kendras play a crucial role in providing medical care, legal aid, psychological counselling, and rehabilitation services to women and children affected by sexual assault. The Commissioner stressed the need for sensitive investigations

while protecting the dignity and privacy of victims. She instructed officials to ensure seamless coordination from case registration and investigation to medical examination, forensic evidence collection, counselling, legal assistance, and rehabilitation. She also directed officials to complete investigations in cases registered under the POCSO Act within the prescribed time and present strong evidence in court. The meeting reviewed measures to strengthen services provided through Bharosa Kendras in Warangal and Jangaon districts.

Farmers allege irregularities in urea sales at Bayyaram cooperative centres



Mahabubabad, July 2: Farmers in Bayyaram mandal have alleged irregularities in the sale of urea at sub-centres operated by the Bayyaram Farmers' Cooperative Society, claiming they are being charged more than the government-fixed price. According to the farmers, an additional Rs.10 to Rs.20 is being collected on each urea bag. They alleged that while the official bill reflects one amount, a higher amount is collected in cash. Some farmers also claimed they were not given bills directly after purchase.

Farmer Poonem Chhinna Lingaiah of Suddarevu village alleged that he paid Rs.1,425 for five urea bags, while the bill issued showed only Rs.1,330, claiming that uneducated farmers were being exploited. The farmers have demanded that the Agriculture and Cooperative Department officials conduct an immediate inquiry into the alleged irregularities and take strict action against those found responsible. They also urged the authorities to ensure fertilizers are sold strictly at government-approved prices.
